

# *Rules*

*To successfully complete the Drivers Education Program,  
the following will be adhered to:*

1. PDS provides 30 hours of classroom time, 6 hours driving time, 6 hours of observation, plus 3 hours computer driving simulator time for each student over a 4-week period. If a student misses any of these hours because of conflicts with other important activities he/she may finish the course with the next session or must make special arrangements to make up the time and graduation requirements.
2. The law and PDS require that no driving be done during the 4 weeks course except with the certified instructor. If this rule is broken, the student forfeits the class fee and can no longer participate in the class.
3. Signing up for driving is very important. When you sign up, we expect you to be at the appointed place and ON TIME! If you miss a driving time and did not give us 8 hours of notice you will be charged \$20.00. A student may drive up to one hour a day and up to 3 hours a week. We begin driving as early as 6 a.m. and end driving as late as 9 p.m.
4. This is an educational class. We expect each student to come prepared with notebook, pen and manual for each class period. Those who are not prepared will get a reduction in their grade. The notebook will be graded and must contain 6 accident reports which may be cut out of newspapers and mounted on a plain sheet of paper or printed from the internet along with 1) causes of accident, 2) explanation how the accident could have been prevented and 3) if occupant were wearing seat belt. The notebook grade is one full grade towards the final grade.
5. There are 6 tests. We require all tests be taken and be passed with a grade of 70% or above.
6. Your final grade is calculated as follows:

6 tests	=	600 points
Driving time	=	100 points (averaged)
Driving (parent drive)	=	100 points
Notebook	=	100 points
Action Homework	=	100 points
Attitude	=	100 points/minus 1100 points
7. A final grade lower than B is not acceptable at the DMV to qualify for a license!!!
8. Each student must fill out both sides of the driver's evaluation form. Evaluation to take place during a drive of approximately 30 minutes.
9. Inspection report by the student of a family vehicle must be assisted by a parent.
10. All 6 action homework slips must be completed.
